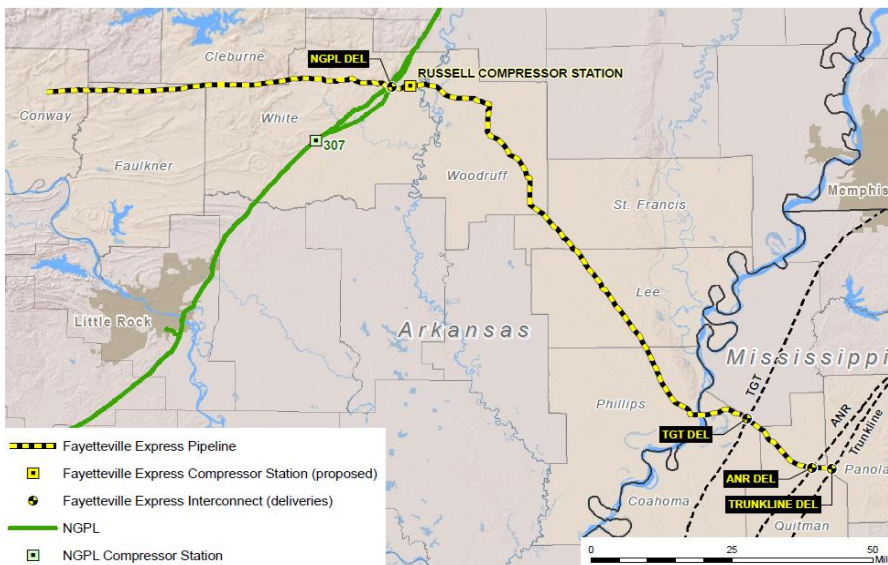




## FEP Continues to Seek Public Input
